1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how RockSalt Subsea Ltd ("RockSalt Subsea", "we", "our", or "us") uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit our website, www.rocksaltsubsea.com ("Website").

This policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, and the choices available to you regarding their use.

By continuing to use our website, you acknowledge that cookies may be used in accordance with this policy and your consent preferences.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites function efficiently, improve user experience, and provide information to website owners.

Cookies may be:

- **Session Cookies** – deleted when you close your browser.
- **Persistent Cookies** – remain on your device until they expire or are deleted.
- **First-Party Cookies** – set by our Website.
- **Third-Party Cookies** – set by external services we use.

3. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to: ensure the Website functions correctly, remember your preferences and consent choices, improve website performance and user experience, analyse visitor behaviour and website usage and maintain website security.

We do not use cookies to collect information that directly identifies individual visitors unless consent has been provided where required by law.

4. Categories of Cookies We Use

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the Website and cannot be switched off in our systems.

They are typically set in response to actions made by you, such as: setting privacy preferences, completing forms, security and authentication functions, load balancing and website functionality.

These cookies do not require consent under applicable data protection laws.

Preferences Cookies

These cookies enable the Website to remember information that changes the way the Website behaves or appears, such as: language preferences, region selection, and accessibility settings.

Statistics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our Website by collecting and reporting information anonymously.

Information collected may include: pages visited, time spent on pages, navigation paths, device and browser information.

Where applicable, statistics cookies will only be activated after consent has been provided.

Marketing Cookies

Marketing cookies may be used to track visitors across websites and help deliver relevant content or advertising.

RockSalt Subsea does not currently use advertising or remarketing cookies. Should this change in the future, this policy and our consent mechanism will be updated accordingly.

5. Cookie Declaration

The cookie declaration is automatically generated and updated by our consent management platform, Cookiebot, to ensure accuracy.

6. Third-Party Services

We may use trusted third-party service providers to support website functionality and analytics.

These providers may include: website hosting providers, website security services, analytics providers (such as Google Analytics) and form processing services.

Where third-party cookies are used, they will be categorised appropriately within our Cookie Declaration and, where required, will only be activated after consent has been obtained.
